

A Biblical Template for Discipleship Men's Ministry

Titus 1:6-9

⁶ An elder must be blameless, faithful to his wife, a man whose children believe and are not open to the charge of being wild and disobedient. ⁷ Since an overseer manages God's household, he must be <u>blameless</u>—not overbearing, not quick-tempered, not given to <u>drunkenness, not violent</u>, NOT PURSUING DISHONEST GAIN. ⁸ Rather, he must be <u>hospitable</u>, <u>one who loves what is good, who is self-controlled, upright, holy and disciplined</u>. ⁹ He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine and refute those who oppose it.


1 Timothy 3:1-12

Here is a trustworthy saying: Whoever aspires to be an overseer desires a noble task. ² Now the overseer is to be <u>above reproach</u>, *faithful to his wife*, <u>temperate</u>, <u>self-controlled</u>, <u>respectable</u>, <u>hospitable</u>, <u>able to teach</u>, ³ not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not <u>quarrelsome</u>, NOT A LOVER OF MONEY.

⁴ He must manage his own family well and see that his children obey him, and he must do so in a manner worthy of full respect. ⁵ (If anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he take care of God's church?) ⁶ He must <u>not be a recent convert, or he may become</u> <u>conceited and fall under the same judgment as the devil.</u> ⁷ He must also have a <u>good</u> <u>reputation with outsiders</u>, so that he will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap.

⁸In the same way, deacons are to be <u>worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine</u>, and NOT PURSUING DISHONEST GAIN. ⁹ They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience. ¹⁰ They must first be tested; and then if there is nothing against <u>them, let them serve as deacons</u>. ¹² A deacon must be faithful to his wife and must manage his children and his household well.










Men Come to Spiritual Maturity When They Disciple other Men! Spiritual truth is not fully rooted in a man (90%) until he has taught it to another man.

90% of a man's life energy will be consumed by the issues of: *Money, Marriage, Raising Children, Sex, Moral Purity, Work and Going through Hard Times.* Does it make sense that we should help Christian men discover Biblical principles on these areas if they are to succeed in life? Which of these topics do you most need help in?

Do you believe we have a Biblical Template from 1 Tim 3, Titus 1, The Great Commandment and Great Commission for Men's Ministry? Why or why not?

Would you be willing to be part of a Men's Ministry Development team that would go through the Every Man A Warrior materials in year 1 in order to experience the materials? Then in year two each man of this team would lead a group in the church?

Before EMAW was released it was field tested for 2 years with more than 500 men in 20 different states. The most frequent comment heard was; *"Why didn't someone tell me these things 20 year ago before I made so many mistakes!"*
