My husband started EMAW when we were living in a place away from our home and families for a time, we believe to refine us. God connected my husband with his EMAW leader in a way that only God can and then used him to speak love, truth, and encouragement into my husband's life.

Those few years that we lived there were the most trying years of our life as we dealt with unemployment, financial struggles, and my husband feeling like he needed to hide things from me instead of talking about them or confessing sin. In his stress he turned more to his addiction to pornography, which he developed as a teenager. When God brought his sin into the light for me to find out about, it tore at the already weary fibers of our marriage.

God used his EMAW group to bring him to a place of confession and call him to accountability. Through Scripture and fellowship, he was taught how to have a quiet time, putting God first in his life, and surround himself with those who will keep him accountable. This, in turn, directly affected our marriage because he was encouraged to be open and accountable to me and ask for forgiveness.

Even as we have moved away from that place, back to our hometown, he has kept in touch with his EMAW brothers. They regularly check in on each other and ask the hard questions to help keep each other's spirit in a place of obedience to the Lord.

While it may always be a temptation, my husband now has the tools to fight against his pornography addiction and has been free of it for almost two years now. God has given him such a desire to disciple other men and teach them the same things that God has shown him. We are currently pursuing ministry options that will allow that opportunity for us.
