

A Biblical Template for Men's Ministry

Titus 1:6-9

⁶ An elder must be blameless, faithful to his wife, a man whose children believe and are not open to the charge of being wild and disobedient. ⁷ Since an overseer manages God's household, he must be <u>blameless—not overbearing</u>, not <u>quick-tempered</u>, not <u>given to drunkenness</u>, not <u>violent</u>, NOT PURSUING DISHONEST GAIN. ⁸ Rather, he must be <u>hospitable</u>, one who loves what is good, who is self-controlled, upright, holy and disciplined. ⁹ He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine and refute those who oppose it.


Here is a trustworthy saying: Whoever aspires to be an overseer desires a noble task. ² Now the overseer is to be <u>above reproach</u>, *faithful to his wife*, <u>temperate</u>, <u>self-controlled</u>, <u>respectable</u>, <u>hospitable</u>, <u>able to teach</u>, ³ not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not <u>quarrelsome</u>, NOT A LOVER OF MONEY.



- 4 will get divorced—effecting more than a million children each year




Real life transformation takes place in a man's love relationship with God.





In the Gospels Jesus taught on money more than any other topic except prayer, faith and the Kingdom of God.







Men come to spiritual maturity when they begin to teach spiritual truth to another man.
