Pastors Who Truly Want to Disciple Their Men

Thank you so much for the phone conversation last night concerning the information about ordering 100 copies of 'EMAW' Book 1 Spanish Edition. I work alongside several mission/ministry organizations ('To the Nations,' Kanisa's Call,' 'Dave Walker International Ministry', and 'New Creation Task for India') basically assisting with discipleship training, sending supplies, construction, and/or carrying luggage. For the past 10 years or so I have been traveling to Santa Cruz, Honduras with Miss Martha Grice with 'To the Nations' assisting with ministry conferences and building projects. About three years ago, we decided to start a Men's Conference in Yamaranguila for about 20 or so pastors and their men taking them through 'The Growing Disciple,' T4T (Training for Trainers), and 'The Principles of a Godly Man.' We have seen little fruit from these conferences until last year when we focused on their needs as men...purity, integrity, family. This year I was led to examine the 'EMAW' material and really liked what I saw. Miss Grice will be going to visit some of the pastors next week and wanted to know if I had the material picked out so she could give it to them in advance to start training. I really think they will be excited about 'EMAW' training and feel that the pastors who are truly wanting to disciple their men will be dedicated to the teaching. Grant L. – Kentucky

- Spring Valley Church of God, Reading PA - 1st group meeting this Friday. They may break into 2 groups depending on the number of guys. The group leader, Frank, is fired up. A big motivational factor for him in the process was NavPress and the Navigators. They have been doing men's frat for about four years with some good success. Frank has invited some guys who are ready to take their walk to the next level.

- Faith Assembly of God, Hazleton, PA. On October 1, the senior pastor will be assembling a handpicked group of guys, key leaders for me to speak to at his church after the service. Ministry to men at this church has been dormant for a little while. Please pray for a revival of ministry to men through EMAW. Please pray that God would rise up leaders at Faith Assembly of God.

- Emmanuel Fellowship Church, Leesport, PA. Emmanuel is a small church. I know a number of people at the church because of their affiliation with my kid's Christian school. Their pastor passed away about a year and a half ago and they have been struggling. The pastor's son-in-law is going to start a group with a couple other guys. Not sure of the start date yet.

Raising the Bar of Leadership is Our Main Thrust

Our men have benefited from your series EMAW. We used it over 2 years as we started it after Christmas year 1. We are just finishing up book 3.
