FILLING UP GAPS



- ★ ✓ Break into pairs and recite your verses from *Book 1* to each other.
 - ✓ Sign off on the *Completion Record*.
 - ✓ Open the session with prayer.
 - ✓ Go around the room, asking each man to share one Quiet Time.
 - ✓ Read the *Foreword*, if you have not done so all ready.
 - ✓ Begin reading the lesson paragraph by paragraph.
 - ✓ Pages 17-26: Ask each of the questions on these pages. Depending on time, have two to four people give their answer. Try to include everyone.
 - ✓ Page 25: Have each man share his *Points To Remember*.
 - ✓ Page 26: Read the *Assignment* together. Have them place Genesis 2:18 in the front pocket of their EMAW Verse Pack. Encourage the men to start working on the other marriage verses as well.



- ★ Have your Quiet Time in these passages this next week: John 13:2-15; Matthew 20:20-28; John 12:23-28; and 1 Corinthians 13:1-13. From now on we will have our Quiet Times on passages that apply to the topic we are studying.
 - \checkmark End in group prayer using the WAR method we learned in Book 1. Pray for your wives and marriages and through any changes you need to make to be the husband God wants you to be.

THE GODLY HUSBAND

It is important to follow the Leader's Guide while leading the lesson. While some items are the same each week, others are special, one-time instructions that will negatively impact the study if missed. These items are marked with a star.

- ✓ Break into pairs and recite your verses to each other. Keep reciting the verses from *Book 1* throughout the entire course.
- ✓ Sign off on the *Completion Record*.
- ✓ Open the session with prayer.
- Ask the men if they remembered to use the suggested passages for their Quiet Times. Encourage them to use these passages to help them develop a greater understanding of the topic.
 - ✓ Go around the room, asking each man to share one Quiet Time.
 - ✓ Begin reading the lesson paragraph by paragraph.
 - ✓ Pages 29–37: Ask each of the questions on these pages. Depending on time, have two to four people give their answer. Try to include everyone.
 - ✓ Page 36: Have each man share his *Points To Remember*.
 - ✓ Page 37: Read the *Assignment* together. Put Ephesians 5:25 and *My Marriage Commitment* in the front pocket of your *EMAW Verse Pack* and memorize them this week.
 - \checkmark End the group using the WAR method of prayer, praying for your wives and marriages. Pray through any changes you need to make to be the husband God wants you to be.

- ✓ Break into pairs and recite all your verses and My Marriage Commitment to each other.
- ✓ Sign off on the *Completion Record*.
- ✓ Open the session with prayer.
- Go around the room, asking each man to share one Quiet Time. Encourage the men to use the suggested passages to help them develop a greater understanding of the topic.
 - ✓ Begin reading the lesson paragraph by paragraph.
 - ✓ Pages 42-46: Ask each of the questions on these pages. Depending on time, have two to four people give their answer. Try to include everyone.
 - ✓ Page 43: Have everyone read his summary rewrite of 1 Peter 4:19.
 - ✓ Page 46: Have each man read his *Points to Remember*.
 - ✓ Page 47: Read the *Assignment*. Have the men place 1 Peter 4:19 in the front pocket of their *EMAW Verse Pack*.
 - \checkmark Page 47: End the session practicing the WAR method of prayer. This may be a time when men want to pray about any hard issues confronting them in their marriages.

- ✓ Sign off on the *Completion Record*.
- ✓ Ask someone to open the session with prayer.
- ✓ Go around the room, asking each man to share one Quiet Time.
- ✓ Begin reading the lesson paragraph by paragraph.
- ✓ Pages 52-59: Ask each of the questions on these pages. Depending on time, have two to four people give their answer. Try to include everyone.
- ✓ Page 60: Have each man share his *Points to Remember*.
- ✓ Page 61: Read the *Assignment* together. Put 1 Peter 3:7 in the front pocket of your *EMAW Verse Pack* and memorize it this week.
- \checkmark End in prayer using the WAR method. Pray for your wife and marriage. Pray through any changes you need to make to be the husband God wants you to be.

- ✓ Break into pairs and recite all your verses to each other.
- You should have ten or more. Sign off on the Completion Record.
 - ✓ Ask someone to open the session with prayer.
- Read the special note on the previous page. Decide as a group if you want to take two weeks on these lessons.
 - ✓ Go around the room asking each man to share one Quiet Time.
 - ✓ Begin reading the lesson paragraph by paragraph.
 - ✓ Pages 65-77: Ask each of the questions on these pages. Depending on time have two to four people give their answer. Try to include everyone.
 - ✓ Page 69: Have each person read their summary on training children from God's perspective in the Greek word paideuo.
- Page 71: Break lesson here. Place the Three Biblical Principles on Raising Children in the front window of your EMAW Verse Pack and start memorizing it this week.
 - ✓ End in group prayer using the *WAR* method and pray for your children.

- ✓ Page 71: Begin reading the lesson paragraph by paragraph.
- ✓ Page 77: Have each person read their *Points to Remember*.
- ✓ Page 78: Read the *Assignment*.
- Page 78: Plan a one-hour outing with one of your children or grandchildren and be prepared to report back to the group.
 - ✓ Page 78: Remind them to use a highlighter or underline in the lesson to help with writing their own Points to Remember.
 - \checkmark End in group prayer using the WAR method. Spend some time praying for your children.

 - \checkmark End in group prayer using the WAR method and pray for your children.

 - ✓ Pages 109-116: Ask each of the questions on these pages. Depending on time, have two to four people give their answer.




- → Page 111: Break lesson here. Place the verse 1 Peter 3:8-9 in the front pocket of your EMAW Verse Pack and memorize it this week.

Assignment for Next Week

★ We have only one week to learn how to share the Gospel message, yet it is one of the most important aspects of being a Christian; especially if it teaches you how to lead one of your children to Christ. There-

fore we will do things a little differently in order to put all our energy and focus on learning this new skill.

- 1. In the back of your book are four verse cards. Pull them out now, and place Romans 6:23 in the front window of your verse pack. Begin to memorize it immediately. Try to memorize all four of the Gospel verse cards in the coming weeks. Start on Romans 6:23, and keep working until you have it solid. It is essential for Lesson 9. Memorize the next three verses after you have mastered Romans 6:23.
- 2. Spend your whole Quiet Time each day studying each of the following verses. Study each verse, every day. Learn them. Meditate on them. Write them out in your Quiet Time journal describing how you might use them to explain the Gospel.

Use John 1:12, John 3:16, Romans 3:23, Romans 5:8, Eph. 2:8-9, 1 Peter 3:18, Revelation 3:20, and 1 John 5:11-12.

- 3. Get started immediately. Use your Quiet Time tomorrow to do the lesson and get started in the process of learning how to share the Gospel using one verse, Romans 6:23.
- 4. Practice The Bridge Illustration each day, either in your Quiet Time, over lunch, or before you go to bed. Use the back of the 4 verse cards for helpful hints.
- 5. Pray for each of the men in your group. The enemy seems to hate it when anyone learns how to share the Gospel. Leading someone to Christ matters for eternity; the salvation of your children or grandchildren may be at stake. "Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be men of courage; be strong." 1 Cor. 16:13
- ✓ End in group prayer using the WAR method. Spend some time praying for each other that they have success in learning The Bridge Illustration this week.

SHARING THE GOSPEL WITH YOUR CHILDREN

- ✓ Break into pairs and recite all your verses to each other.
- ✓ Sign off on the Completion Record.
- ✓ Ask someone to open in prayer.
- ★ ✓ We will not share Quiet Times this week since the verses will be discussed on page 125. We will need this time to practice sharing the Bridge Illustration on page 126.
 - ✓ Page 120-125: Read the story and The Bridge Illustration.
 - ✓ Page 125: Discuss the Bible verses. "How could each verse help someone understand the Gospel or be used to answer a question about the Gospel?"
- ★ ✓ Page 126: Break into pairs and practice sharing The Bridge Illustration with each other. Try to have 30 minutes for this part of the lesson. Have your partners check if you use the key Gospel phrases listed at the bottom of the page.
 - ✓ Encourage the men to keep practicing The Bridge Illustration until they can do it well. We will practice The Bridge Illustration again next week instead of doing verses and sharing Quiet Times.
- ★ ✓ Encourage the men to memorize all four of the verses on evangelism. Read 1 Peter 3:15 together, and remind the men that we are commanded to "always be prepared" to share our faith.
 - ✓ End the group in prayer using the WAR method. Spend some time praying for your children.
