Skills to Help Memorize Scripture for a Lifetime

1. Have a Quiet Time on each of these verses. Reread the verse a couple of times and jot down why this verse is important.
2. Always say the reference before and after quoting the verse. The reference is the hardest part to remember. Saying it twice helps it stay connected to the verse.
3. Practice saying the reference and the first phrase of the verse together. This will help in getting the verse started. Then add the next phrase. Keep adding phrases until you have the whole verse. Say the verse out loud whenever possible and strive to say the verse word-perfect.
4. After you have learned the verse, try to review it a couple of times a day. If you daily review a learned verse, for seven weeks, it will stay with you for life.
